

OCLC Transparency Report –1 April 2025

Purpose

This report is prepared for purposes of the EU Digital Services Act, and relates to OCLC, Inc. and its subsidiaries (including OCLC UK Ltd., OCLC B.V., OCLC GmbH, OCLC AG, and OCLC S.r.l.), which are collectively referred to herein as “OCLC”.

Reporting Period

This report covers the period from when OCLC first became subject to the Digital Services Act through 31 March 2025.

Scope of Report

- OCLC’s proxy service software (when hosted by OCLC) EZproxy
- OCLC’s library patron e-book, streaming video, and streaming audiobook services CloudLibrary and related technologies
- OCLC’s SaaS (software as a service) products for the management of libraries, library-related services, and curated materials management, a list of which is available at <https://www.oclc.org/en/services.html>.

Orders Received from Authorities

No Articles 9 or 10 orders concerning alleged illegal content were received from authorities during the reporting period.

Notices of Alleged Illegal Content

No Article 16 notices of the presence of specific items of allegedly illegal content were received from individuals or entities during the reporting period.

Content Moderation

During the report period, no Article 15 content moderation activities involving OCLC products or services were conducted by OCLC on its own initiative. No complaints were received concerning content moderation activities. No automated means or “trusted flaggers” were used in content moderation activities.
